

# Christmas gnomes pattern



## Materials

- 4 US 2½ - 3.0 mm DPN  
- A bit of sport weight yarn  
(I used Cheval Blanc Tobiane)

## Abbreviations

K - knit  
F - purl  
CO- cast on  
k2tog - knit two together

## The cork robe

CO 21sts on 3 needle (7 stiches on one needle)

Round 1-4: P to end of round

Round 5: K to end of round

Round 6: \*1 K, k2tog, 4 K\* repeat to end of round

(6 stich remains on one needle; 18 stiches together)

Round 7-16: K repeat to end of round (you can change yarn color after every even row during knit rounds to have a striped robe)

Round 17-20: P repeat to end of round

Round 21: cast off purlwise

## Tiny hat

CO 18sts on 3 needle (6 stiches on one needle)

Round 1-12: K to end of round (you can change yarn color after every even row during knit rounds to have a striped hat)

Round 13: \*1K, k2tog\* repeat to end of round (4 stich remains on one needle)

Round 14: P to end of round

Round 15: \*1K, k2tog, 1K\* repeat to end of round (3 stich remains on one needle)

Round 16: K to end of round

Cut yarn, leaving a tail. Thread the tail onto a tapestry needle and sew it through the remaining stitches twice. Weave in any remaining ends and tuck in the bottom of the hat.

Let's put the gnome together!
